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NEW REPORTING GUIDANCE FOR FACILITIES CONDUCTING POINT-OF-CARE (POC) COVID-19 TESTING

The Washington State Department of Health (DOH) is introducing new guidance on reporting results for facilities conducting point-of-care (POC) COVID-19 testing. All facilities administering POC testing for COVID-19 must report all of their COVID-19 testing results directly to DOH. Reporting COVID-19 test results is legally required by Washington State WAC 246-101 and Washington State Board of Health's emergency rule, [WAC 246-101-017](#).
